BPC helped form the **Emergency Shelter Partnership (ESP)** organization and for years since then has coordinated with congregations in Westchester to assure that those most vulnerable among us can count on a warm welcome, nutritious meals, and safe place to sleep. The EMERGENCY SHELTER PARTNERSHIP relies on the spirit of giving to sustain efforts from November through March -- and this year, even a pandemic can't stop the love. As always, though, it takes a Village, so please consider when and how best to devote your time and talents to it!

To adapt to demands that protect the public health in this era of Covid-19, the ESP this year will be physically hosted by three churches within walking distance of the Mt. Kisco Police Department. Supporting congregations coordinate to deliver:

- single-serving dinners
- snack bags
- A helper to assist for a half-hour in the nightly reception of homeless guests.

BPC is on duty during the first week of **January (Sunday 1/3 through Sunday 1/10)** and **March (Monday 3/1 through Sunday 3/7)**. Please check your calendars to decide when you might be able to pitch in, and thanks in advance for your generosity of spirit!
