Woman 2 Woman Sponsors Photo Exhibit at the Katonah Village Library

The Town of Bedford is home to more than 1,000 women who are incarcerated at Bedford Hills and Taconic Correctional Facilities, yet most of us know very little about the women who live behind those walls. Please join Woman 2 Woman and the Katonah Village Library as we present *Inside & Out*, a selection of Sara Bennett's extraordinary photographs of women currently serving or released from lengthy sentences at these prisons. The exhibit **will run through April 30th**.

Before becoming a photographer documenting women with life sentences, Bennett worked for eighteen years as a public defender with a specialty in representing battered women and the wrongly convicted. She hopes her work "will shed light on the pointlessness of extremely long sentences, arbitrary parole denials, and what to do with a redeemed life."

In conjunction with the exhibit, W2W is also organizing two evening panel discussions. "**Mothers in Prison**", on **Wednesday, April 1st**, will feature women who were incarcerated at Bedford Hills and Taconic and the stories of how they raised their children while inside. "**Getting Out: Parole and Re-Entry**", on **Wednesday, April 22nd**, will feature Robert Dennison, a retired Chairman of the New York State Parole Board, and several formerly incarcerated women, all of whom will be discussing the process and the need for reform. **Both events will be from 7-9 pm at the Katonah Village Library.**

Woman 2 Woman was founded at Bedford Presbyterian Church in 2013. During these past seven years, we have connected more than 100 women from this community with women incarcerated at Bedford Hills and Taconic. There is much to be proud of.
