

Starting with just a few basic supplies, you can create beautiful, colorful eggs very simply. Eggs can be plastic, wood, Styrofoam, plastic, or real blown out eggs. You can use tissue paper, paper napkins, comics, or even light weight sheet music for the music lovers in your family. Then with just a little Mod Podge you are on your way to a beautiful basket of decorative eggs that last for years.

Tissue Paper Eggs

Materials: egg; tissue paper (cut into 1-inch squares); newspaper; Mod Podge; paintbrushes; scissors

Directions: Using the brush, spread a small amount of Mod Podge onto an egg. Place a piece of tissue paper or newspaper over the glue and press it down with the brush.

Continue working this way until the entire egg is covered in paper. Place the eggs on a parchment lined cookie rack or plastic plate to dry.



Napkin Eggs

Materials: egg; decorative napkins (cut out small pieces); Decou-Page Matte; paintbrush; scissors

Directions: Pull the layers of the napkin apart & save only the layer with the pattern on it; Cut out pieces of the paper napkins (by cutting small pieces of the pattern napkin, this will prevent bubbles and folds); Apply decoupage to the egg and place the cut-out napkin on top; Apply a layer of decoupage over the napkin and smooth out with your fingers.
